

# Allflex EID-Maxi Visual Matched Sets



## General Description

The Allflex EID-Maxi Visual Matched sets are a combination of HDX High Performance Ultra EID tag with a matching Maxi Visual tag with corresponding laser/ink printed numbering. The full EID number is printed in the neck area of the visual tag. All tags feature Tamperproof design.

The Allflex package of EID tags include a bag code. This bag code can be entered in the Allflex EID Tag Number Look Up site ([www.allflexlink.com](http://www.allflexlink.com)), and the numbers contained in the package can be downloaded. All bags contain a User Guide for the Website. This information can be easily migrated or merged to an existing database or management program without any reading equipment.

## Options

The EID-Maxi Visual Matched sets are available in five customizable combinations, which include basic tags with a management number to combinations with logos and reverse-side marked text. Available in seven colors.

## Packaging

The Matched Sets are packaged in a plastic tray in sets of five tags. The standard quantity per bag is 25 sets.

## Recommended EID Tag Placement for Cattle

Application site must be free of foreign debris prior to placement of tags on the animal. Review application instruction prior to tagging.

1. The EID tag should be placed in the middle of the ear between the two cartilage ribs close to the head.
2. The female portion of the tag should be on the inside of the ear with EID tag application. Note that this is a thicker part of the ear. Application may be more difficult than when applying a visual tag.
3. **IMPORTANT:** Caution, "Free Air Space" is critical for proper healing and retention. Inspect placement after tagging to insure there is sufficient space between ear and EID tag.
